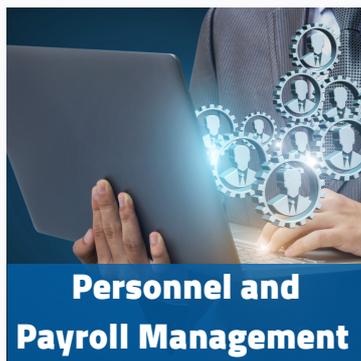

**2** The system provides instant access to vital and fundamental financial data through the general ledger, with the ability to prepare comprehensive and flexible reports on the general ledger, revenues, expenses, and assets.

**3** Review detailed financial reports in your company, including balance sheets, income statements, cash flow statements, and profit and loss reports, to help you make necessary business decisions to achieve your business goals, in addition to daily journal entry reports including general ledger accounts, cost centers, and other relevant reports, along with expense and revenue reports that can be issued according to classification.

**4** Adding daily journals entry for financial transactions with the ability to classify each transaction by category and choose the foreign currency according to the daily or period conversion rate, with the ability to allocate accounts to cost centers, profit centers, or additional centers.

**5** Through chart of accounts, infinite number of levels can be added, with the ability to specify the final level at any level without the need to reach a specific level to be final, as well as the ability to change the main account or account type by changing its main account easily and at any time.

# Accounts Payable

- Through the payments and accounts payable system, you can able to following and management of all accrued transactions such as invoices for goods, services, miscellaneous expenses, and payment of these dues according to the payment terms and methods specified in the invoices helps the company fulfill its obligations to others.
- The accounts payable system facilitates improving cash flow and relationships with suppliers by providing timely, accurate, and efficient invoice processing and payment, analyzing available liabilities, tracking purchases and expenses. The system also provides an effective way to adding purchases, supplier invoices, and allocate expenses to cost and profit centers.
- Possibility of defining suppliers and categorizing them at the company or all companies' level to prevent duplication of suppliers and facilitate the extraction of consolidated reports for common suppliers.
- Possibility of categorizing suppliers up to 5 categories, specifying for each supplier payment terms, payment methods, currency, shipping method, bank, and the bank account for the supplier.
- Control at the supplier level on the credit limit, whether a fixed amount or period, and specifying the start and end of the contract if it exists, in addition to the ability to stop issuing payments or Adding purchase orders, or suspending the supplier, In addition to the exempt taxes for each supplier.
- Defining banks and branches, specifying the accounts of each bank in different currencies, checkbooks, and check sequences, in addition to different payment terms and methods, and linking each payment method to its specific account based on the type of payment method.
- Defining methods, terms, companies of shipping to be selected in purchasing transactions for shipment tracking.





# Accounts Payable

- Defining company expenses by category and in detail to track expenses total and detailed, in addition to additional costs for shipments such as shipping expenses, customs, and others to add them to the received shipment value.
- Entering purchase invoices and their returns manually or automatically by linking with the purchase order, with the possibility of directly affecting the warehouses or need to entering a stock receipt transaction.
- The ability to purchase using different currencies with specifying the payment and shipping terms and conditions.
- Viewing the accounting entry arising from the transaction with the ability to modify the accounts before transferring to general ledger, with the possibility of transfer from within the invoice transaction.
- The ability to create a purchase invoice on different warehouses and with more than one unit of measure per item.
- The ability to fix the purchase price for each item using the latest purchase invoice price, with the possibility of discounting at the item and invoice level together.
- Linking the purchase invoice to a specific project to track purchases of materials on the project to track project cost and not exceed the estimated material budget for the project.
- Creating company expense invoices, whether from a supplier or an employee, with the ability to allocate each expense to a cost center and a profit center.
- The ability to track shipping expenses by creating invoices for shipping expenses added to the purchase invoice or store receipt to allocate additional shipping costs.





# Accounts Payable

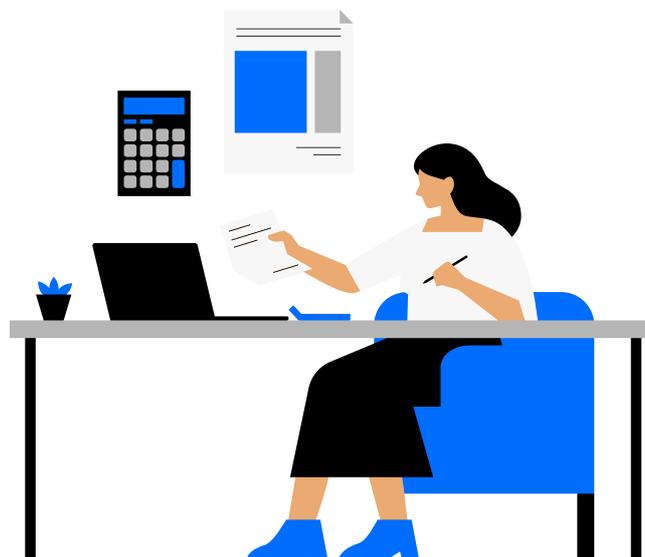
- Issuing payments with different payment methods, with the ability to link each payment method to more than one account and specifying the due date for each check, in addition to allocate the payments to a cost or profit center to identify and track payments for each project and supplier.
- The ability to know and track paid and unpaid or partially paid transactions, whether from within the payment, purchase, return, or expense transaction, or from reports according to the supplier or during period.
- Ability to create credit and debit note to settle supplier accounts, with the ability to pay for these transactions.
- Entering the additional expenses for shipments in a separate transaction to allow allocate these expenses on the purchase invoice or store receipt.
- The additional expenses are allocated to the shipments in various ways, such as price, quantity, weight, or equally, for each expense type.
- The system provides analytical reports that show purchase invoices in more than one detailed format and summarized within a period and according to each branch, for item or item categories, supplier or supplier categories, local or foreign, according to the due date or expected delivery date, according to the buyer or the registering user.
- Purchase invoice reports are grouped by items or item categories - by suppliers or supplier categories - by branches or warehouses.
- Reports for tracking material purchases by value and quantity according to the cost and profit center of the projects.
- Monitor payments transactions through different payment methods from treasury and bank accounts, in addition to tracking detailed and total company expenses according to cost and profit centers.
- Track the movement and balances of suppliers through a supplier statement of account in local and foreign currency and a supplier's trial balance.
- Track full and partially received purchase invoices.



# Accounts Receivable

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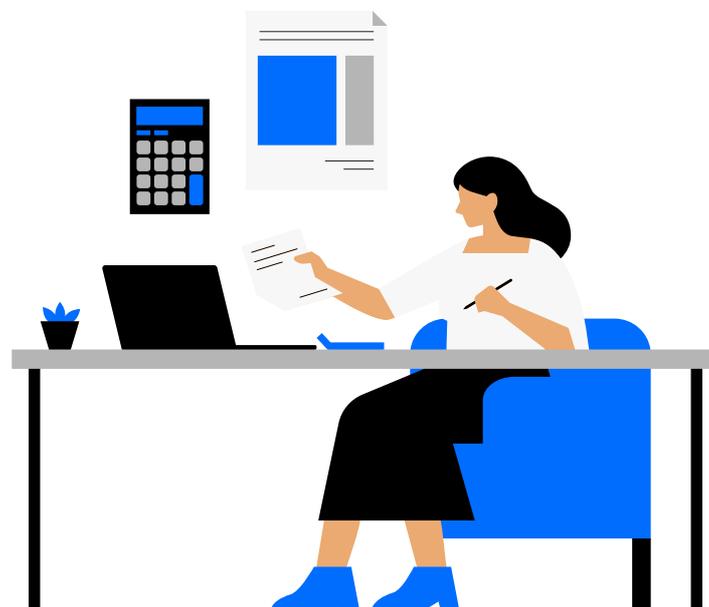
- Through accounts receivable system, all the company's due invoices are tracked, whether they are for products or services provided to customers, along with their payment schedules, in addition to tracking the payment transactions made by customers. This helps the company understand its cash flow situation.
- Receivables management is improved by facilitating accurate processing of invoices and their aging, delivering timely statements of account, collecting revenue, as well as effective credit management. It provides comprehensive control over customer and credit management information.
- Customers can be defined and classified for one company or shared between sister companies to prevent repetition of the same customer and facilitate the extraction of consolidated reports on shared customers.
- Customers can be classified into up to 5 categories, with payment terms, payment methods, and currency specified for each customer.
- Control can be at the customer level, setting a credit limit either by amount or period, with the option to specify the start and end dates of the contract if applicable, in addition to the ability to set a special selling price and salesperson responsible for each customer, with the option to stop issuing sales invoices or to stop the customer altogether, with tax exemptions specified for each customer.
- Some of sub-customers can be linked to a main customer.
- An infinite number of selling prices can be defined for use in pricing products with special authorities.
- Sales invoices can be tracked for customers according to their due date for following the collection or expected delivery date.
- Sales invoices can be issued for different business units according to sales branches, as well as at different selling prices according to product pricing or special selling prices according to customer categories.



# Accounts Receivable

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- It is possible to issue invoices with specific specifications for items with variable dimensions of length, width, and height, and to calculate the quantity sold by square meter, cubic meter, or linear meter according to the number of units.
- Sales invoices and returns can be added manually or automatically by linking with sales quotation or sales order, depending on the sales life cycle.
- Ability to track and monitor paid, unpaid, or partially paid transactions, whether through receipt voucher or sales invoices and returns, or through reports by customer or period.
- Ability to create debit and credit note to settle customer accounts, with the ability to pay for these transactions.
- Detailed and summarized reports on sales and returns during a certain period, based on branch, item or item categories, customer or customer categories, due date or expected delivery date, salesman, invoices paid or unpaid.
- Ability to monitor sales volume by tracking sales and returns by item or item categories, by customer or customer categories, by branches or warehouses, by salesmen, and by daily sales.
- Provides you with reports to know profits and losses on the level of item, invoice, customer, cost center and profit center.
- Monitor collection transactions in detail and summary by payment methods and different accounts.
- Knowledge of customer movement and balances through a statement of account for a sub or main customer, or for a customer linked with a supplier, and a customers' review trial balance in addition to extracting a report showing customers' debt aging for various periods that can be defined according to customer categories.





# CASH MANAGEMENT



The cash management system enables you to manage daily transactions, cash balances, fund transfers, and bank account reconciliations in one place.



By using Edari system for cash management, you can monitor, predict, and manage cash through multiple options using customizable reports and simplified bank reconciliation processes, in addition to tracking information about incoming and outgoing cash flows, all of which occur as business need to support the most accurate decision-making.

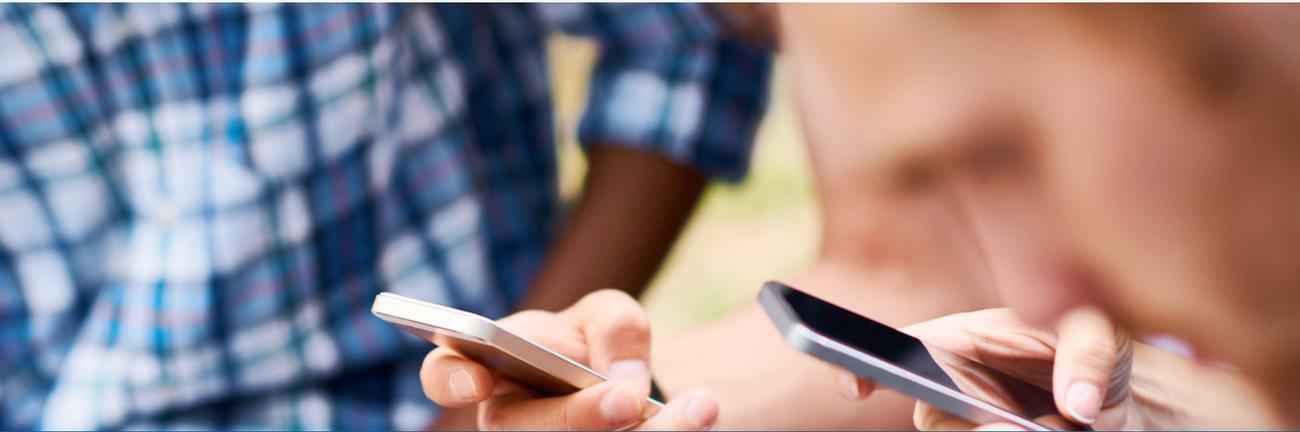

# SALES MANAGEMENT

- Through an Edari system, the sales administration works to improve customer service by enabling the processing of requests quickly and efficiently and executing them accurately and on time.
- Increase your team's productivity to the maximum by using our efficient design for accessing the system and customizing screens to simplify and enhance your workflow according to your unique business rules.
- Through the sales and order management system, you can access customer account information to simplify the ordering process, with visibility of the customer's status, credit limits, previous orders, and confirmation of customer billing and shipping addresses.
- When customer orders are filled and completed, sales order information flows through the system so that you can issue invoices and ship orders on right time.
- The sales and order management system is specifically designed to save time for manufacturers and distributors in a large part of the sales process, order management, and execution.
- These orders can come directly from end-users or indirectly from original equipment manufacturers, partners, and other customers.
- Sales invoices and their cash returns are added in various payment methods according to the company's needs, manually or based on a price offer, sales order, or reservation of goods for a cash customer.





# SALES MANAGEMENT

- The ability to convert a price offer or sales order into various types of sales invoices automatically to speed up the invoicing process accurately and save time, effort, and reduce errors, following the company's documented cycle.
- Monitor the production process by tracking the stages that are performed on the materials ordered.
- Track sales movement starting from customers' price quotation requests and converting them into sales quotations, sales orders, and then to work order with one button click, according to the sales and production cycle.
- The ability to reserve customers' items until sales invoices or store issue are issued to ensure that they are not accidentally disposed of.
- Possibility to evaluate sales management according to the displayed price offers that have not been converted into actual sales, through detailed and summarized reports with advanced search features that help improve sales.
- Tracking sales orders, work orders, and delivery stages for customers through analytical and summarized reports.
- Extracting cash sales reports and their returns in more than one display method, grouped by different payment methods or by Items and Items categories - by salesmen - by branches.
- Extracting detailed reports to obtain a clearer view of your business performance, profit and loss, detailed sales transactions by items, customers, salesmen, or time periods.





# PROCUREMENT MANAGEMENT



- Procurement tools in an Edari system help simplify and streamline tendering, purchasing, and receipt processes by imposing policies and approvals on requests paid for by the workflow. This can help reduce purchasing risks, improve purchasing governance, and achieve lower costs.
  - Inventory can be automatically replenished by raising a purchase order or creating a supply chain transfer from the supply warehouse. This is done by setting inventory warning levels and specifying minimum quantities that must be available in the inventory. When inventory falls below these minimum levels, a purchase order is automatically generated to ship the required quantities. This helps avoid inventory depletion and ensures that the required quantities are always available.
  - The ability to track received purchase orders according to shipments or unreceived ones.
- You can start the procurement cycle by registering an internal purchase requisition, then registering a request for purchase quote from the supplier, and then added transaction of the received price quotes from the suppliers. After approval of one of the purchase quotes, it can be converted to a purchase order based on the purchase quote. All of this can be executed with a single click, and the appropriate documents are created automatically. This makes it easy to add purchase transactions, monitor, and manage the procurement cycle smoothly and quickly.
  - The ability to prioritize and importance purchase requests for the company or projects internally or externally.
  - The ability to track purchase orders according to the date of need and the expected delivery date - by the shipping method, terms, and shipping company.
  - Reports that explain purchase quote and purchase order transactions in more than one detailed or summarized form during a period and according to each branch - each project - by item or items category - supplier or suppliers' category - local or international - according to the buyer.
  - Reports of purchase order transaction are available in more than one way, grouped by items or items categories - by suppliers or suppliers' categories - by projects - by branches and by warehouses.



# INVENTORY MANAGEMENT

The ability to monitor inventory accurately at any time to ensure smooth operations of sales and production around the clock, in addition to identifying and following up with the procurement department on materials that are required to ensure the company's operations are running smoothly.

The role of inventory management is to coordinate the company's procedures and requirements so that inventory is stored in the appropriate place, at the right time, and in the appropriate quantities to meet customer requirements or production processes.

Using advanced workflow technology and product management, you get visibility of the inventory's location and movement, with expiration dates or specific shipping sequences.

An inventory management system provides you with precise control over the inventory's movement in the warehouse, with available and reserved balances and costs managed professionally.

The ability to add an infinite number of items with different types such as inventory, kit, finish product or service, with their own classifications up to 10 levels, custom dimensions of length, width, and height, determining the wastage ratio and the minimum quantity sold. at one company or shared between sister companies to prevent item duplication and facilitate the extraction of consolidated reports for shared items.

Alerts are available for quantities according to the minimum and maximum limits and the identified reorder quantities of the item.

Ability to define different units of measure for each item, with the inclusion of price lists and barcodes for each unit of measure, as well as a specific supplier for each item to track items sales by supplier.

Addition of multi alternative items and approved suppliers for the items, in addition to attachments.





# INVENTORY MANAGEMENT

Monitoring of movement received and issued free items at the level of the customer, supplier, and items.

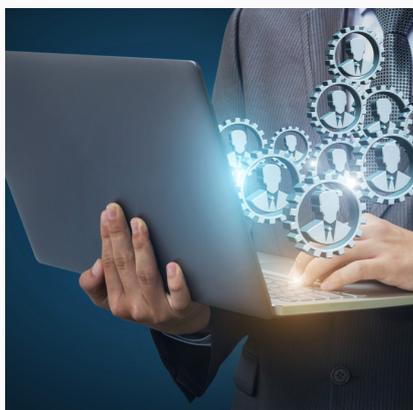
